Empowerment Congress West Area NDC (ECWA) supports council file CF 23-0002-S35 which states with the concurrence of the Mayor, the City of Los Angeles includes in its 2023-24 State Legislative Program support of California state assembly bill AB 36 (Gabriel) which expresses the intent of the legislature to enact legislation to prohibit a person subject to a domestic violence protective order from owning, possessing, purchasing or receiving a firearm for an additional three years after the domestic violence protective order has expired, unless the court finds the person to not be threat to public safety.
