

RULES, ELECTIONS AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL RELATIONS COMMITTEE REPORT and RESOLUTION relative to establishing the City's position regarding Assembly Bill (AB) 776 (Holden), which would require the California Department of Transportation to work with California tribes local to, or historically located along, State Route 210 and designate the highway as the Southern California Native American Freeway, and erect signage.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Resolution (Rodriguez - Blumenfield), SUBJECT TO THE CONCURRENCE OF THE MAYOR:

RESOLVE to include in the City's 2023-24 State Legislative Program SUPPORT for AB 776 (Holden), which would require the California Department of Transportation to work with California tribes local to, or historically located along, State Route 210 and designate the highway as the Southern California Native American Freeway, and erect signage.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Chief Legislative Analyst (CLA). The City Administrative Officer has not completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted

SUMMARY

At its meeting held on September 15, 2023, the Rules, Elections and Intergovernmental Relations Committee considered a CLA report and Resolution (Rodriguez - Blumenfield) to include in the City's 2023-24 State Legislative Program a position on AB 776 (Holden), which would require the California Department of Transportation to work with California tribes local to, or historically located along, State Route 210 and designate the highway as the Southern California Native American Freeway, and erect signage.

After providing an opportunity for public comment, the Committee recommended that Council approve the recommendations in the CLA report and adopt the Resolution. This matter is now forwarded to Council for its consideration.
