Summary: The United Neighborhoods of the Historic Arlington Heights, West Adams and Jefferson Park Communities Neighborhood Council (UNNC) recognizes the critical role that mature trees play in enhancing the City's green infrastructure in order to drastically reduce the threats associated with extreme heat, climate change, and environmental justice. We know that access to shade, cooling, green space, and natural resources significantly increases resiliency and equity for communities across the City. We support an investigation of sustainable solutions to sidewalk repairs, with a focus on the preservation of mature trees.
