

TRADE, TRAVEL, AND TOURISM and TRANSPORTATION COMMITTEES REPORT relative to a proposed superseding Freeway Agreement with the California Department of Transportation in connection with the State Route- 47/Vincent Thomas Bridge and Front Street/Harbor Boulevard Interchange Reconfiguration Project.

Recommendation for Council action:

AUTHORIZE the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), in compliance with Section 100.22 of the California Streets and Highways Code, to execute the superseding Freeway Agreement with Caltrans, attached to the Council file, as approved by the City Attorney to form and legality, to reflected improvements along the SR-47 Freeway and adjacent local streets, which will occur during construction of the SR-47/Vincent Thomas Bridge and Front Street/Harbor Boulevard Interchange Reconfiguration Project.

Fiscal Impact Statement: The LADOT reports that there is no impact to the General Fund.

SUMMARY
