

MOTION

The City of Los Angeles is currently in the process of conducting an inventory of skateparks across the city. As captured in Council File 23-0239, the Department of Recreation and Parks is working to report on the condition of all existing skateparks in the City, and the identification of funds for a consultant team to develop a strategic plan or master plan for identifying sites for new skateparks. As such, this document will be vital for both the skateboard community and the residents of the surrounding communities. Building out this vision strategically and with community expertise and involvement is crucial to ensuring that skateparks remain a publicly accessible space. Identifying stakeholders of these parks can allow for a participatory planning process. In order to obtain a better understanding of the process of this effort, the Department of Recreation and Parks should coordinate with the local residents and skateboarding communities at large to establish a working group for the inventory of skateparks.

**I THEREFORE MOVE** that the Department of Recreation and Parks be requested to report to the Neighborhoods & Community Empowerment Committee on the process and plan needed to establish a citywide "Skatepark Advisory Group". This report should look to the San Pedro Skatepark Association's successful collaboration related to building and maintaining skateparks in Council District 15.
