

MOTION

I HEREBY MOVE that the Council ADOPT the following recommendations in order to effect settlement in the case entitled Carolyn Williams v. City of Los Angeles, et al., Los Angeles Superior Court Case No. 21STCV19333. (This matter arises from a slip and fall incident that occurred on June 29, 2020, at 12141 Iredell Street, in the City of Los Angeles.) **SUBJECT TO THE APPROVAL OF THE MAYOR:**

1. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney’s Office to expend up to **\$160,000** in settlement of the above-entitled Storm-Related General Fund liability Sanitation matter.
2. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney to draw a demand from fund No. 100/59, Account No. 009798, Miscellaneous Liability Payouts as follows: Manuwal & Manuwal and Carolyn Williams in the amount of \$160,000.
3. AUTHORIZE the City Attorney, or designee, to make necessary technical adjustments, subject to the approval of the City Administrative Officer, and authorize the Controller to implement the instructions.
