MOTION

In accordance with State Law, the City Clerk is compiling petitions to establish the Historic Core Business Improvement District (BID). The BID would serve the community by providing such services as corridor clean up, graffiti removal, landscaping and beautification. The boundaries of the proposed BID include both privately-owned parcels and City-owned parcels.

The City has previously supported BID formation efforts in areas where the City owns property. Given that the City owns several parcels in the proposed BID boundaries, the Council should instruct the City Clerk to sign the petition for the City-owned parcels.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the City Council instruct the City Clerk, or designee, to sign the petition for the City-owned parcels included in the Historic Core Los Angeles Business Improvement District.

I FURTHER MOVE that the City Clerk be authorized to make any changes or adjustments to the above instructions in order to effectuate the intent of this Motion.
