

MOTION

I MOVE that the matter of the PUBLIC WORKS COMMITTEE REPORT relative to issues relating to the sale, lease and rental of recreational vehicles (RV) in the public right of Way, Item No. 8 on today's City Council agenda (C.F. 23-0529), BE AMENDED to also adopt the following additional recommendations:

4. REQUEST the City Attorney to report back on the feasibility of including a requirement individuals engaging in the illegal rental of oversized/recreational vehicle to be required to pay relocation expenses for any individuals dwelling within the vehicle, including repayment of any illegally collected rental arrears for the duration of their stay;

5. INSTRUCT the City Administrative Officer to report back within 30 days on how this code amendment impacts and/or aligns with the the Citywide Rehousing Strategy for People Experiencing Recreational Vehicle (RV) Homelessness; and

6. INSTRUCT the CAO to prepare recommendations for how fines collected during enforcement of the amended code can be invested and integrated to help fund the Citywide Rehousing Strategy for People Experiencing Recreational Vehicle (RV) Homelessness.
