

TRADE, TRAVEL AND TOURISM COMMITTEE REPORT relative to a railroad crossing related quiet zone feasibility study throughout the entirety of Council District 15.

Recommendation for Council action, pursuant to Motion (McOsker – Park):

REQUEST the Port of Los Angeles to:

1. Report with a phased timeline of a quiet zone feasibility study throughout the entirety of Council District 15, including a preliminary list of high priority crossings due to the noise and environmental impacts to the surrounding community.
2. With the assistance of the City Administrative Officer (CAO), to identify available funding for implementation of a quiet zone feasibility study throughout Council District 15.

Fiscal Impact Statement: Neither the CAO nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.
