

PUBLIC SAFETY COMMITTEE REPORT relative to the acceptance of a non-monetary donation of a Citywide Traffic Workload Study valued at \$34,200 for the Los Angeles Police Department (LAPD) Traffic Services Bureau.

Recommendation for Council action:

APPROVE and acceptance of the non-monetary donation from the Los Angeles Police Foundation of a Citywide Traffic Workload Study (2023-006) valued at \$34,200 for the LAPD Transit Services Bureau; and THANK the donor for this generous donation.

Fiscal Impact Statement: None submitted by the Board of Police Commissioners (Board). Neither the City Administrative Officer nor the Chief Legislative Analyst has completed a financial analysis of this report.

Community Impact Statement: None submitted.

Summary:

On September 12, 2023, your Committee considered an April 12, 2023 Board report relative to the acceptance of a non-monetary donation of a Citywide Traffic Workload Study valued at \$34,200 for the LAPD Traffic Services Bureau. According to the Board, this donation will provide a study of the Citywide traffic workload for the Transit Services Bureau. The results of this study will be used to develop a system for traffic deployment similar to the Patrol Plan used by the Office of Operations. Currently, the four traffic commands in Traffic Group are staffed exclusively with positions from the Table of Organization, with no consideration to the flexibility of workload. Approval of this grant will provide a data-informed model and allow the Department to make strategic decisions regarding deployment. After consideration and having provided an opportunity for public comment, the Committee moved to recommend approval of the donation as detailed in the Board report. This matter is now submitted to Council for its consideration.
