Summary: The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council (SCNC) supports Council File 23-4118-S2: Title, Designation of Prohibited Locations / Riverside Drive and 134 Freeway / North Hollywood Red/Orange Line Station / North and South Weddington Park / Vineland Avenue and 134 Freeway, etc. / Council District 2/ Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 41.18. Homeless encampments are again on the rise in and around Studio City, including at Riverside Drive/134 freeway, Vineland/134 freeway, Tujunga/101 freeway, the Red/Orange Line station, and South Weddington Park. Open drug use, fires, litter, unsanitary practices, sidewalk obstructions, and criminal activity are rife in these areas. Residents and stakeholders have complained about these unsafe and growing encampments and want more to be done. A 41.18 special enforcement zone designation would prevent individuals from sitting, lying, sleeping, or storing, using, maintaining, or placing personal property, or otherwise obstructing the public right of way. The SCNC applauds Councilmember Krekorian for introducing this important resolution that will give the LAPD an enforcement tool to deal with the service resistant. We hope that Councilmember Raman also supports this 41.18 designation to ensure that our residents, disabled persons, and children can safely travel through these troubled areas of Studio City.



The Board of the Studio City Neighborhood Council (SCNC) supports Council File 23-4118-S2: Title, Designation of Prohibited Locations / Riverside Drive and 134 Freeway / North Hollywood Red/Orange Line Station / North and South Weddington Park / Vineland Avenue and 134 Freeway, etc. / Council District 2/ Los Angeles Municipal Code Section 41.18. Homeless encampments are again on the rise in and around Studio City, including at Riverside Drive/134 freeway, Vineland/134 freeway, Tujunga/101 freeway, the Red/Orange Line station, and South Weddington Park. Open drug use, fires, litter, unsanitary practices, sidewalk obstructions, and criminal activity are rife in these areas. Residents and stakeholders have complained about these unsafe and growing encampments and want more to be done.
