Currently, when a person visits City Hall, they must go through a security screening and are given a single-use "visitor" sticker that they must wear while in the building. These stickers are single use, which creates unnecessary trash. In addition, some visitors remove them and stick them on walls or other surfaces, requiring additional work by the Department of General Services to remove them. These stickers should be replaced with something that is non-sticky and reusable.

I THEREFORE MOVE that the Police Department's Security Services Division and the Department of General Services BE DIRECTED to identify a reusable, non-sticky visitor tag or badge for visitors at City Hall, to replace the single-use "visitor" stickers currently in use.
