ORDINANCE NO. _____

An ordinance repealing Ordinance No. 188005, a special election ordinance for an initiative that has been withdrawn from the March 5, 2024 ballot.

WHEREAS, on July 20, 2022, the City Clerk presented the City Council with a certified initiative petition in support of a proposed ordinance regarding hotel land use, replacement housing, and police permit requirements and a program to place unhoused individuals in vacant hotel rooms;

WHEREAS, on August 5, 2022, the City Council responded to the initiative petition by adopting a resolution, pursuant to City Charter Section 452, directing that the initiative submitted to the voters at the City’s regularly scheduled election to be held on March 5, 2024;

WHEREAS, on September 26, 2023, the City Council adopted an ordinance calling a special election for the initiative to be held on March 5, 2024 (Ordinance No. 188005);

WHEREAS, on December 1, 2023, the proponents of the initiative petition filed a request with the City Clerk to withdraw the initiative ordinance from the ballot, consistent with the withdrawal procedures of the City Charter and City Election Code;

WHEREAS, the City Council has adopted a Resolution approving withdrawal of the initiative ordinance from the ballot; and

WHEREAS, having received and approved a request to withdraw the initiative from the ballot, the Council wishes to repeal the ordinance which had called a special election for the initiative (Ordinance No. 188005).

NOW, THEREFORE,


**THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF LOS ANGELES
DO ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:**

Section. 1. Ordinance Number 188005 is hereby repealed.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk shall certify to the passage of this ordinance and have it published in accordance with Council policy, either in a daily newspaper circulated in the City of Los Angeles or by posting for ten days in three public places in the City of Los Angeles: one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall; one copy on the bulletin board located at the Main Street entrance to the Los Angeles City Hall East; and one copy on the bulletin board located at the Temple Street entrance to the Los Angeles County Hall of Records.


