

## RESOLUTION

Resolution withdrawing a citizen-sponsored initiative from the March 5, 2024 ballot regarding the following subject: minimum wage for employees working at certain healthcare facilities.

**WHEREAS**, on June 10, 2022, the City Clerk presented the City Council with a certified initiative petition in support of an ordinance establishing a minimum wage for employees working at certain healthcare facilities; and

**WHEREAS**, on June 21 and June 29, 2023, the City Council responded to the initiative petition by adopting the ordinance proposed in the initiative petition; and

**WHEREAS**, opponents of the initiative ordinance thereafter circulated and filed a certified referendum petition against the ordinance, staying the effective date of the ordinance until it is approved by the voters; and

**WHEREAS**, on September 30, 2022, the City Council responded to the referendum petition by adopting a Resolution pursuant to City Charter Sections 452 and 462 to place the initiative ordinance on the March 5, 2024 ballot; and

**WHEREAS**, on October 26, 2023, the proponents of the referendum petition against the initiative ordinance filed a request with the City Clerk to withdraw the initiative ordinance from the ballot, consistent with the withdrawal procedures of the City Charter and City Election Code; and

**WHEREAS**, on November 9, 2023, the proponents of the initiative petition in support of the initiative ordinance also filed a request with the City Clerk to withdraw the initiative ordinance from the ballot, consistent with the withdrawal procedures of the City Charter and City Election Code; and

**WHEREAS**, withdrawal of the initiative ordinance from the ballot requires the approval of the City Council.

### **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. The City Council hereby approves the proponents' request to withdraw the initiative ordinance described above from the March 5, 2024 ballot.

Sec. 2. The City Clerk is authorized and directed to take all actions necessary to withdraw the initiative ordinance from the March 5, 2024 ballot.
