I would be happy to provide any additional information. Please note that our street has not been repaired in over 25 year. Much of the damage is from the Northridge earthquake! No one ever got back to me as promised in the 2023 email below. Please help me get something done to improve the situation with our road. It's unfathomable that I continue to be ignored and dismissed. Excuses I have received from your office over the last 10 years of trying. 1. The road is too steep. How is this acceptable? There are steeper roads all over LA and they get paved. Please at least pave the flat sections of the road. 2. There is too much work to be done so it can't be done at this time. Received that one year ago. I continue to pay taxes and watch as the roads surrounding me get paved multiple times. Please do the work. I would appreciate a response with a timeline of when Esparto Street will be paved. Thank you On Tue, Jun 13, 2023 at 8:56?AM Seth Samuels wrote: Thank you for your email. I wanted to let you know that a representative from the Bureau of Engineering Geotechnical Division is supposed to be on your street later this week to evaluate the street for repaving and, potentially, other road improvements that may be necessary. Each time I have requested that something be done to repair the street that I live on in Woodland Hills. Each time I have been given a different reason why, but the answer has always been NO SORRY YOU ARE NOT A PRIORITY. At this point, 11 years later I am completely fed up and terribly frustrated. Perhaps the fact that the street that runs adjacent to my

street just got completely repaved AGAIN. I live on Esparto St, Woodland Hills, CA 91364. There are five houses on this street. Pampas and Galendo Street are on each side of Esparto and are constantly being repaired. When I called your office this week, I was told that is because Esparto is considered a street in "Poor" condition so it will take more resources to get it done and is therefore not a priority. I can understand that reasoning to a point. However, if you look at your records you will see that this street still has damage from the Northridge earthquake. It has not been repaired in over 25 years!!!! It is completely inequitable and I would like to live on a street that isn't a hazard to myself and my children. I have attached pictures for you to see the condition of the street and a couple pictures to see the condition of Galendo Street. Thank you for your time.
